### Minutes of Meeting

The meeting of IQAC Cell, Centurion University was held and the following resolutions were taken by the Board;

1. It was felt that as per the latest trends and notification of UGC, Centurion University has to design and develop its entire programme with more skill orientation and will try to meet the NSQF framework. As a stepping stone it was decided to offer skill courses in free electives basket of B.Tech programme and elective basket of MBA programme. These courses shall be offered in line with the courses offered by Sector Skills Councils (SSC) under NSDC. The evaluation of these courses shall be 100% internal. Students will be trained to qualify level certification by respective SSC.

2. It was unanimously decided to redesign the curriculum leading to more elective theory and skill courses that will meet the programme objective like; Employment, Higher Studies and Entrepreneurship. Students can choose any track based on his/her career objectives. The concerned HoDs are advised to develop the new curriculum and discuss in department BoS meeting.
3. University will apply for NAAC accreditation in year 2014-15 and accordingly the action shall be taken by Registrar with support of all HoDs, IQAC Coordinators and NAAC Coordinators of PKD campus and Jatni campus..
4. IQAC Coordinators of both the campus will periodically review the progress made by respective department in complying the requirements for NAAC documentation.
5. As proposed by Dean- Academic, members agreed to introduce open book examination systems in Research Methodology exam of Ph.D programme.
6. It was resolved to introduce external evaluation in Lab/Practice papers of undergraduate programmes.
7. It was proposed to publish University Journal with ISSN registration. Chief Librarian Mr. Tapas Bhuyan will take necessary action in getting registered by ISSN and publish at the earliest.
