## CENTURION UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY & MANAGEMENT – A PROFILE...

- Jagannath Institute of Technology and Management was established in the year 1997 as an Engineering College, promoted by JITM Trust, Paralakhemundi.
- Centurion Institute of Technology was established in the year 2008 as a city campus at Jatni, Bhubaneswar.
- Centurion University of Technology & Management was declared as a Multisector Private State University vide Orissa Act 4 of 2010 and gazetted duly by the Higher Education Department in December, 2010.
- CUTM has four constituent colleges namely:
  - Jagannath Institute of Technology & Management, Paralakhemundi.
  - Centurion Institute of Technology, Jatni, Bhubaneswar.
  - Jagannath Institute of Technology & Management, Rayagada Center.
  - Jagannath Institute of Technology & Management, Bolangir Center.
- All constituent colleges are gazette notified.
- UGC – AICTE team visited this University on 30-09-2011 and found that all the programmes are meeting UGC/ AICTE parameters. This is required for 2(f) status under the UGC act.

The mandate is skill building of youth with special focus on school dropouts. Most of the students of the programmes are SC/ST boys and girls. On an average ten thousand trainees undergo training. The company is the first partner of National Skill Development Corporation of India. It has developed partnership with companies as well as various State Government.
  - Gram Tarang Foods Limited (GTFL): Gram Tarang Foods is producing superior quality CO2 extracts (select oils, oleoresins & total extracts) from raw spices and herbs.
  - Gram Tarang Self Help Co-operative Limited (GTSHCL): Runs a seed grading and processing unit.
  - Gram Tarang Inclusive Development Service (GTIDS): The Company has enrolled more than 1 million customers as a part of financial inclusion of Government of India. The Company partners with Genpact for technical support. It work initiative in about 6000 villages spread across India in partnership with various banks.
  - Bapuji Rural Enlightenment & Development Society (BREDS): "Being a value based social development wing of Centurion, BREDS has been carrying out impact oriented sustainable development initiatives, with the strong support of the Bread for the World (Germany), and NABARD, Hyderabad."
  - School of Disaster Management: It is a recent start-up. It has played supportive roll in the recent cyclone and flood affected areas in Ganjam & Gajapati district.

## PLACEMENT:

At Centurion University, we focus on Community, Inclusion and Employability probably more than any single institute in the country. Our emphasis is on employability, not “employment”. Employment can be achieved through short cuts, and we don't take those.

Our Career Development Cell focuses on inculcating the right set of skills and attitudes in the students, so as to make them ready to face the challenges of the industry from the day one. The students have to undergo compulsory customized training on behavioral, communication, aptitude, as well as specialized technical skills from the very first semester itself.

Through our corporate connects across industry verticals, we provide campus recruitment opportunities to all of our eligible students. Our standing and image among the corporate sector can be gauged from the fact that blue chip organizations like Accenture, Tata Consultancy Services, Infosys, Triveni Turbine, Mindtree, Dell, IBM, Honda, Samsung, Axis Bank, ING Vysya Bank, Bosch, Nissan Renault etc. have recruited candidates from our campuses over the period of last few years.
