## About the Workshop

Sharp increase in frequency of occurrence of extreme weather condition related disaster poses new challenges across globe. Research Institutes in most countries are engaged in serious field evidence based studies to improve policy and implementation tools to mitigate the disaster risks. Effective response to disaster depends upon various stakeholders, among which the local community plays a critical role. Globally, it is well known that local communities have saved more human lives than any other agency and have shown wide range of innovation in promoting adaptation and coping abilities. However, community based response to disaster recovery and preparedness has not yet been scientifically documented adequately and hence, facilitation towards community empowerment for better performance has remained suboptimal.

Therefore, the School of Climate and Disaster Studies (SCDS), Centurion University of Technology and Management (CUTM), Odisha, India, has planned to undertake Participatory Research in Disaster Management in collaboration with universities, institutes and experts across the globe. Accordingly, we have planned to host a 2-days' workshop of experts at our Bhubaneswar campus on the aforementioned theme.
