

Policy for Re-registration and Continuation in doctoral programme at CUTM

Those doctoral candidates who have been de-registered due to non-performance in research work (at the end of 5 years), can get a chance to get into the programme through a process of **Re-registration**. Their earlier admission will be valid which means that they will not be asked to give another registration seminar for admission.

They will be allowed to submit their **final thesis in two years time** provided they meet the following requirements:

- 1) Clearance of Research Methodology course work.
- 2) Clearance of subject course work if any.

Re-registration would imply:

- 1) New fee structure will be applicable.
- 2) Undergoing subject course work (as it is mandatory after 2015 by the UGC).

Other Ph.D regulations (placed in CUTM website) are applicable.
