#### **About the Session**

Writing a research proposal engages a number of skills such as Subject knowledge and research skills, Critical thinking skills, and communication skills. The FDP organized by CGSS highlighted how to write a good research proposal. A standard template with Background to the topic, significance and research problem, Research aims and questions, Review of literature, Study/project design, Timeline, Expected outcomes/impact was discussed followed by questions and answers.

#### Objective:

 To state the problem, hypothesis and the research steps needed for progress towards a solution.

#### Outcomes:

Successful proposals are likely to share two qualities: 1) an attractive, workable scientific idea framed as a testable hypothesis, and 2) a logical research plan that has been clearly and concisely communicated to a non-expert reader. We have already hinted at this last quality and it bears emphasis: mail reviewers and ad hoc panel members will be evaluating your proposal as a significant, additional burden on their already heavily committed time and energy
