#### About resource person:

Dr. V. Narsimha Reddy, Professor, Genetics & Plant Breeding, M S Swaminathan School of Agriculture, Centurion University, Odisha, joined as Assistant Professor in Acharya N.G. Ranga Agricultural University, Ranjendra Nagar, Hyderabad (now, Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University) on 23-07-1986. Served in Research, Extension and Teaching for 32 years at various Research Stations and retired as Principal Scientist & Head, Maize Research Centre, ARI, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad-30 on 31.10.2018. He has experience in breeding Groundnut (2 years), Rice (13 years) and Maize (9 years) crops. Further, he was responsible for seed research and breeder seed production of various crops for 8 years.

#### About the session:

Intellectual property rights (IPR) refers to the legal rights given to the inventor or creator to protect his invention or creation for a certain period of time. These legal rights confer an exclusive right to the inventor/creator or his assignee to fully utilize his invention/creation for a given period of time. The session aims to Help and aid academicians pursuing research by ensuring protection to their ideas and research work. Critical to foster innovation basically for research scholars, PhD Students and Innovators.
