About the Session: A One-day Seminar on Modern Concepts in Agriculture was organized on 4th December 2017 in the Conference Hall, School of Management, Paralakhemundi Campus. The inaugural session began with the lighting of lamps and invocation. Prof. K. Prasad Rao, Director, Research and Extension, MSSSoA, in his opening remarks emphasized on the mechanization of modern agriculture. Prof. Ramana Murthy, Head, Agriculture Research Station, Ragolu, Andhra Pradesh spoke on the farmer needs, and intensification and diversification of farming to increase productivity. Prof. Murthy highlighted how different institutions are marching forward to adopt villages, and integrating technology to offer solutions. "Information Technology (IT) + Agriculture Technology (AT) = Mighty" was the punchline of his talk to improve the agriculture sector.
