



The webinar was mentored by Dr.Dipankar Bhattacharya Pro-Vice Chancellor(Research & Learning) of Centurion University and coordinated by Dr.Girija Nandini, associate professor School of Management.


Dr.Dipankar Bhattacharya addressed innovation and design patents. A design patent is a form of legal protection of the unique visual qualities of a manufactured item. A design patent may be granted if the product has a distinct configuration, distinct surface ornamentation or both. To qualify for a design patent, the subject must be new in the sense that no single, identical design exists in the prior art, it must satisfy the ornamental standards, and it must be original to the inventor or inventors seeking protection. He suggested participants to do some designs by using their creativity. He also said that he can facilitate participants further. He shared his thoughts about how to get a patent from an idea. He informed that he will discuss the innovation patent in next session in which participants can share their own ideas or thoughts to him so that he will convert those ideas to genuine patents.


There are 75 participants in this webinar. CIE members and two management students, Satyajit Behera and Ankita Mohanty helped in coordinating the event.




