Objective:

The OER concept strengthens traditional academic values of sharing and collaborative creation of knowledge. While this general description of OER is positive, it builds on scattered data and somewhat anecdotal evidence. This clearly demonstrates the need for further research on the

OER movement in general, for more evaluations of individual projects as well as better user statistics to build a better knowledge base.
