2) The team members were informed about the online mentoring in each section of the schools. The complaints were discussed. The chairperson emphasised the need for timely action.

3) The university counsellor reported the counselling given online for the Hostel inmates on benefits of Meditation & discipline.

4) Girls hostel superintendent proposed to have organise a webinar on 'responsibility of student' for the students.

5) Committee decided to set up an awareness programme on Cyber Crimes & Safety Measures in the coming week.
