


Online Program on Fitness & Self Defence


1. <u>Celebration Of Gandhi & Shastri Jayanti and International Day of Non-</u> <u>Violence</u> Date: 2nd October 2020




2. National Youth Day Date: 12th January 2020





Taranga Fest Date: 16th March 2018






Fig: Photo of the drawings presented during the online session
