2. *Prof Mukti Kanta Mishra* proceeded with an in-depth presentation on the activities of CUTM for the benefit of the members present.
3. The proposed fee structure was deliberated at length and the following fee configuration was agreed upon unanimously by the Committee:

## Centurion UNIVERSITY

From the discussion that ensued, the following basic tenets emerged and agreed upon by the Committee:

- The fee structure shown earlier would be used as the ceiling for the academic years 2011-13.
  - The University would adopt appropriate practices and strategies to facilitate access to higher education for deserving students coming from economically weaker sections.
  - It was proposed that 10% of the total sanctioned seats would be reserved for the economically challenged and meritorious students. In case the 10% allotted seats are not filled up, the same seats could be released for regular students.
  - The fee structure should be such that it would align itself with the Vision of the University, i.e. to encourage and promote the access of the deserving students coming from weaker and marginalized sections to higher education.
  - The fee-structure would encompass the principle of cross-subsidy (not exceeding the ceiling) so that the students hailing from a more affluent section of the society, who are somewhat weaker in academics, have to bear higher fees, compared to those coming from economically challenged backgrounds.
  - The fee account heads would comprise heads such as, "Tuition Fees" and "Development Fees and Others". In the latter account head all such sub-heads would be included that cover student welfare and allied development.
  - The present fee structure would be accepted as, "INTERIM", that would be re-visited after the entire financial structure has been re-worked and finalized.
4. The meeting ended with a warm vote of thanks for the Chairman and Members, by the President of CUTM.
