





Life is not easy for everyone i saw people who lived their 70-80% of life now they are living their rest life at the worst situation .





16) "Health and Wellness Marathon" on the occasion of World AIDS Day, 1st of December, 2022



18) Participation in Consultation with Youth on Budget for Climate Change by Youth4Water at Centre for Youth and Social Development (CYSD) on 27th of December, 2022

Youth4Water organization held a session on Budget for Climate Change to map a perception among youth on the upcoming budget towards Risk Resilience and Climate Change on 27th of December, 2022 at Centre for Youth and Social Development (CYSD). 5 selected students from Centurion University have attended the program.

The details of the program are as follows:

- The session began at 10:30 AM with a briefing on what the meeting is all about. Guests Ms Jyoti Sharma, Program Director Youth4Water, Ms Shipra Saxena, and Shri Birupakya Dixit were enthusiastically invited onto the stage.
- After introduction of all of the visitors the session began by pouring water from little clay pots to giant clay pots thus signifying "If everybody can pour little thoughts into a single huge pot, it will create a large change in the community. Then Shri P.K Sahoo's inspiring comments "We demand action against climate change, and we want it soon" motivated all.
- Then Ms Jyoti Sharma, Shri P.K Saho, Ms Namita Pattanaik, and Omkar Khara shared their perspectives on how the environment is changing and how it affects Odisha. Many students expressed their opinions on how Odisha is dealing with climate change, such as winter days are shortening and Odisha has seen an increase in cyclones in recent years.
- Omkar Khara began his presentation by displaying a slide illustrating how Odisha is susceptible and is ranked 'TEN' in all Assam and Maharashtra are placed 'ONE' and 'THREE' respectively, whilst Odisha is ranked 'TEN'.
- Shri Birupakya Dixit of Practical Action expressed his insights by discussing the genuine concerns confronting the youth and how the government is addressing climate change in its budget.
- Then, CYSD gave a presentation on consultation with youth on risk resilience and climate change, and some questions were answered, such as
 - Why is the budget essential from people's perspectives?
 - The budget includes approximately 2 lakh crores.
 - Climate change has 11 departments such as Agriculture, Health, Fisheries, Panchayat Raj, and so on, and each department has a percentage of the department share.
 - Government-sponsored schemes.
- Later, at 12.20 PM, They were divided into three groups, each led by three coordinators who coordinated the group and its sub-coordinators. There were four primary issues that needed to be addressed in the group.
 - What are the youth's perceptions of climate change in connection to its causes and consequences in Odisha?
 - What are the critical pieces of information and awareness needed for youth to take action on climate change issues?
 - How many youth play an essential part in the formation of local institutions?
 - In your opinion, what are some measures for climate change adaptation in Odisha in terms of WASH, agriculture, and health?
- After determining who belonged to which group, all groups were assigned to different conference rooms for discussion
- A quick intro talk was given to formally introduce everyone at the discussion. Then the talk about climate change and its causes started. Students, scholars, social activists, and representatives from other organisations were present in each group. Each and every one of them addressed the concerns thoroughly. The discussion then moved on to how to raise awareness about climate change in each rural and urban culture, and we took part in it. The debate then lasted until 2:20 p.m.
- Then after lunch we continued our conversation in the auditorium. The respected three groups presented their ppt presentations in front of the Dias researchers and other members. The CUTM students were also present and were part of the presentation group.
- At the conclusion of the presentation, Mr N.K Mahakud, Retired Professor at Sambalpur University, took the platform and highlighted his life and college

experience in fighting against climatic challenges, as well as climatic conditions in his day and today.

- At 4:30 PM, followed by Mr N.KMahakud's segment, Shri. Santakar Chelapila, a Journalist, expressed some beautiful things about the mountains and Visakhapatnam people and how they managed climatic challenges.
- Finally, Dr Krushna Chandra Pal concluded the session with a motivational song sung by all participants, and the session concluded at 5.20 PM.

20) Centurions in 5G Services Inauguration Program at SoA University on 5th of January, 2023

Inauguration of 5G Services in Odisha was done in a program hosted at Soa University, Bhubaneswar in presence of Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw, Hon'ble Minister of Communications, Electronics & IT and Railways, Govt. of India on 5th of January, 2023. The launch event was accompanied by an Exhibition from technology companies, STPI participants, CDoT and Telecom service providers on Communications & IT products and 5g use case in various socioeconomic sectors viz. health, education, tourism, mining etc.






22) BhuFeSto: Bhubaneswar Festival of Story Telling






