Accessible Facilities

- **Ramps and Elevators** in academic, administrative, and residential buildings ensure campus-wide mobility.





- **Wheelchair Access** with smooth pavements, wide corridors, and specially designed entrances.



- **Electric Vehicles for Campus Transport** to assist students and staff with mobility challenges.



- **Accessible Washrooms** equipped with support railings, wide doors, and user-friendly fixtures.



- **Signage with Universal Symbols** to support navigation for visually impaired and cognitively challenged individuals.



- **Assistive Technology Labs** – equipped with screen readers, braille printers, and speech-to-text tools.



- **Accessible Library Resources** – e-books, audio books, and digital repositories. Centurion University's library is a hub of knowledge equity with over 2,55,550+ beneficiaries and seating for 220 learners. It provides both digital and physical access to premier databases such as IEEE Xplore, Web of Science, Scopus, J-Gate, and ProQuest covering technology, science, management, law, agriculture and humanities. It empowers students, faculty, researchers, and community learners with global knowledge resources.

- **Campus Accessibility Audits** – regular reviews in collaboration with NGOs and disability experts. MoU with SVNIRTAR enables campus accessibility audits and inclusive designs and MoU with Composite Regional Centre (Bolangir) strengthens rehabilitation and accessibility strategies.
