About the Event

We, on behalf of School of Forensic Sciences, observed the National Forensic Week 2022 at Centurion University of Technology and Management, Bhubaneswar Campus on 20th and 21st September 2022 to mark the 10th annual celebration of Forensic Science and to acknowledge the contribution that forensic science makes to the criminal justice system. The theme of the event was "Forensics: Looking beyond the Obvious". This two day event was an excellent opportunity to network with forensic professionals and gain knowledge about scientific research in various forensic disciplines.

DAY 1 (20th September 2022)

The Chief Guest for the event was Dr. Aruna Kumar Swain, Former Assistant Director, State Forensic Science Laboratory, Rasulgarh, Bhubaneswar, Govt. of Odisha. The esteemed Chief Guest, along with Prof. Supriya Pattanayak, Vice Chancellor, CUTM, BBSR and Dr. Prasanta Kumar Mohanty, Dean- Academic, CUTM, BBSR, inaugurated the event. The keynote speaker was Dr. Debendra Muduli, Asst. Professor, Department of Computer Science & Engineering, NIT Rourkela, Odisha. In the inaugural session, a welcome dance was performed by the students of the department.

Prof. Supriya Pattanayak delivered an introductory speech as the head of the institution and spoke about how Centurion University has consistently shown itself to be a pioneer in social consciousness and the pursuit of a better tomorrow. DAY 2 (21st September 2022)

Day 2 of the event was marked by the some activities for the students which includes group discussion and quiz competition. There was one technical session on "HPTLC-Instrumentation and its applications" by Mr. Ramakant Yadav, Resource Person from Anchrom Enterprises (I) Pvt. Ltd., where he explained the basics of the instrument and about the identification, fingerprinting and HPTLC bioassays and EDA. Members from School of Pharmacy and Life Sciences & Centre for Drug Design also actively participated in the technical session.

Post lunch break, Prof. KVD Prakash, Dean, HRD, CUTM, BBSR addressed the gathering with his inspiring words. A prize distribution ceremony was conducted and all the awardees were felicitated to acknowledge the talent of the position holders in poster presentation, group discussion and quiz competition.
