


WORKSHOP REPORT: JOB PREP WITH BOTS

1. Resume Crafting Practice: Participants were given the chance to work on their resumes using AI-powered tools, with guidance from the workshop facilitator.


2. Interview Simulations: Attendees actively participated in BOT-powered interview simulations, gaining hands-on experience and valuable insights into their interview skills.

3. Essay Writing Workshop: A practical essay writing exercise allowed participants to utilize BOT assistance and receive immediate feedback on their writing.




