1. Anti-Ragging Principle

CUTM has strict "Zero Tolerance' towards any form of ragging as described in this Supreme Court judgment. Ragging is strictly banned in college premises and anybody found indulged in such activities will be strictly punished.

Ragging is an offensive and demeaning practice imported from abroad and is contrary to our cultural ethos. CUTM has a Zero tolerance policy towards ragging, & this practice will be curbed by the administration at all costs. Interrogation of fresher, instigation to rag, threatening and ill treatment of fresher will be treated as act of ragging along with indulging in actual ragging in any form, shape, grab or guise committed either inside or, outside the hostel or institute. Ragging is a serious offence which will result in serious disciplinary action including rustication. To curb ragging the help of whole administration will be taken.

2. Action to Curb Ragging

The University Administration will form Anti Ragging Committee and Anti Ragging Squad.

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the Supervisory and Advisory Committee on matters of Planning Action for Building and Preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the University Campus. The Anti-Ragging Squad will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation, for any incidences of Ragging, and shall educate the students at large in the University about Menace of Ragging and related Punishment Provisions. Anti Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plan for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the University by adopting array of activities.

Any case of Ragging that is observed or reported will be dealt by the Anti-Ragging Committee.

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the University, the **possible punishments** for those found guilty of ragging at the University level shall be any one or a combination of the following:

- 1. Cancellation of admission
- Suspension from attending classes
- 3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- 4. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- Withholding results
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- 7. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Rustication from the institution for a period as may be determined by appropriate authority
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution of the University
- 10. Fine of Rupees 25,000/-

11. Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

As a preventive measure, all the existing students, freshers' shall submit an undertaking (online) in the prescribed form in the beginning of the academic session itself.

ANTI - RAGGING POLICY

1. Anti-Ragging Principle

CUTM has strict "Zero Tolerance' towards any form of ragging as described in this Supreme Court judgment. Ragging is strictly banned in college premises and anybody found indulged in such activities will be strictly punished.

Ragging is an offensive and demeaning practice imported from abroad and is contrary to our cultural ethos. CUTM has a Zero tolerance policy towards ragging, & this practice will be curbed by the administration at all costs. Interrogation of fresher, instigation to rag, threatening and ill treatment of fresher will be treated as act of ragging along with indulging in actual ragging in any form, shape, grab or guise committed either inside or, outside the hostel or institute. Ragging is a serious offence which will result in serious disciplinary action including rustication. To curb ragging the help of whole administration will be taken.

2. Action to Curb Ragging

The University Administration will form **Anti Ragging Committee and Anti Ragging Squad**.

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the Supervisory and Advisory Committee on matters of Planning Action for Building and Preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the University Campus. The Anti-Ragging Squad will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation, for any incidences of Ragging, and shall educate the students at large in the University about Menace of Ragging and related Punishment Provisions. Anti Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plan for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the University by adopting array of activities.

Any case of Ragging that is observed or reported will be dealt by the Anti-Ragging Committee.

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the University, the **possible punishments** for those found guilty of ragging at the University level shall be any one or a combination of the following:

- 1. Cancellation of admission
- 2. Suspension from attending classes
- 3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- 4. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- 5. Withholding results
- 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- 7. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- 8. Rustication from the institution for a period as may be determined by appropriate authority
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution of the University
- 10. Fine of Rupees 25,000/-

11. Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

As a **preventive measure**, all the existing students, freshers' shall submit an undertaking (online) in the prescribed form in the beginning of the academic session itself.

Policy on Sexual Harassment

Date: 01.07.2019

The Centurion University of Technology and Management, Odisha (CUTM) is committed to creating and maintaining a community in which students, teachers and non-teaching staff can work together in an environment free of violence, harassment, exploitation, and intimidation. This includes all forms of gender related violence, sexual harassment, and discrimination on the basis of sex/gender. While CUTM is committed to the right to freedom of expression and association, it also strongly supports gender equality and opposes any form of gender discrimination and violence.

The Supreme Court of India, in 1997, in the Vishaka Judgment, for the first time, acknowledged sexual harassment at the workplace as a human rights violation. The Supreme Court relied on the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW), adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations, in 1979, which India has both signed and ratified. In its judgment, the Supreme Court outlined the Guidelines making it mandatory for employers to provide for sympathetic and non-retributive mechanisms to enforce the right to gender equality of working women.

The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 ("Sexual Harassment Act") has been made effective on December 9, 2013 by way of publication in the Gazette of India.

The Sexual Harassment Act has been enacted with the objective of providing women protection against sexual harassment at the workplace and for the prevention and redressal of complaints of sexual harassment. Sexual harassment is considered as a violation of the fundamental right of a woman to equality as guaranteed under Articles 14 and 15 of the Constitution of India ("Constitution") and her right to life and to live with dignity as per Article 21 of the Constitution. The right to practice or to carry out any occupation, trade or business in a safe environment free from harassment is guaranteed under Article 19(1)(g) of the Constitution.

The definition of sexual harassment in the Sexual Harassment Act is in line with the Supreme Court's definition in the Vishaka Judgment and includes any unwelcome sexually determined behaviour (whether directly or by implication) such as physical contact and advances, demand or request for sexual favours, sexually coloured remarks, showing pornography, or any other unwelcome physical verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature.

The Sexual Harassment Act stipulates that a woman shall not be subjected to sexual harassment at any workplace. As per the statute the following may amount to sexual harassment:

- presence or occurrence of circumstances of implied or explicit promise of preferential treatment in employment;
- · threat of detrimental treatment in employment;
- · threat about present or future employment;
- interference with work or creating an intimidating or offensive or hostile work environment; or
- humiliating treatment likely to affect the lady employee's health or safety.

In view of the guidelines of the Vishaka Judgement 1997 against sexual harassment and as mandated by the Sexual Harassment at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 ("Sexual Harassment Act") (Gazette of India), CUTM has constituted a Committee Against Sexual Harassment (Internal Complaints Committee) effective from July 2019. The Committee comprises faculty, administration, service staff and

students' representatives. Besides internal representation, the Committee has few invited external members.

Role of the Committee:

- To prevent discrimination and sexual harassment against women, by promoting an amicable and safe environment for students and employees in all campuses of CUTM.
- To make recommendations to the Vice-Chancellor for changes/ elaborations in the Rules for students in the Prospectus and the Bye-Laws, to make them gender just and to clearly formulate procedures for the prohibition, resolution, settlement and prosecution of acts of discrimination and sexual harassment against women, by the students and the employees.
- To deal with cases of discrimination and sexual harassment against women, in a time bound manner (90 days), aiming at ensuring support services to those victimized and initiate action against perpetrators.
- To recommend appropriate action (punitive) against the guilty party to the Vice- Chancellor.


Procedure for Approaching Committee:

The Committee deals with issues relating to sexual harassment at the Centurion University of Technology and Management in all its campuses. It is applicable to all students, staff and faculty. A complaint of discrimination or sexual harassment may be lodged by the victim or a third party. A written complaint may be addressed to the Convener of the Committee. If the complaint is made to the Vice-Chancellor, Pro-Vice-Chancellor and Directors of the concerned campus, or any of the Committee members, they may forward it to the Convener of the Committee Against Sexual Harassment. Centurion University has a mechanism for redressal of students' grievances related to academic and non-academic matters, such as assessment, victimization, attendance, charging of fees, conducting of examinations, harassment by colleague, students, teachers, etc. There are Grievance Redressal Committees at the Campus/University levels to deal with the grievances of the students.
