The Pulse of Healthcare at the Mela – A Nursing Perspective

In line with the theme of *Recent Advancements in Nursing*, the **School of Nursing** proudly set up a dedicated **healthcare stall**. Over two days, the stall became a hub of compassionate care and clinical precision. With a crowd of over **200 individuals**, the nursing students—mainly from **1st and 2nd year B.Sc. (Nursing)**—efficiently conducted **vital checks** using the **Telemedicine Instrument**, which exemplifies how technology is now seamlessly woven into nursing practice.

Guided by our esteemed **Vice-Principal, Prof. S.N. Sandhya**, the stall also extended **free medical consultations**. Prof. Sandhya personally interacted with the attendees, offering expert advice and **prescribing medications** for various common health issues, thereby making quality care accessible right at the heart of the rural community.

MediTrack App – The Future of Medication Management

Adding to this transformative journey is the development of the **MediTrack App**, a cutting-edge innovation currently in progress. This **QR code-based medication tracking app** is designed to make prescription management easier, safer, and more responsive:

- **Real-Time Alerts:** The app uses a **green light** to indicate when it's time to take medication and a **red light** to show when not to.
- **Personalized Reminders:** It helps users stay aligned with their doctor's prescription schedule.
- **Caregiver Support:** Family members and caregivers can receive **instant notifications** about missed or incorrect doses.
- **Patient Safety:** Reduces the risk of errors and enhances adherence through **interactive, user-friendly alerts**.

This innovation represents a significant leap in **personalized, tech-enabled nursing care**—bridging the gap between clinical accuracy and at-home convenience.

Healthcare on Wheels – Vision on the Move

Another standout aspect was the active involvement of **Healthcare on Wheels from Bhubaneswar**, in collaboration with **faculty and students from CUTM Andhra Pradesh campus**. Their services brought eye care to the doorstep of villagers. On the first day alone, **160 individuals underwent eye checkups**, followed by **165 on the second day**. The initiative concluded with the **distribution of 320 free spectacles**, an act that was not just corrective but deeply transformative for those whose livelihoods depend on sharp vision.

The afternoons were intellectually charged with **panel discussions** on topics ranging from **livestock development, aquaculture, farm mechanization, crop protection, and alternative farming strategies**. The **Quiz Competition for Farmers** added an element of interactive learning and entertainment, empowering participants with knowledge while also celebrating their wisdom.

The second day was equally enriching, featuring motivational talks by award-winning farmers like **Dr. Raimati Ghiuria** (Millet Queen of Odisha), **Shri Sudam Sahu** (Rice Man of Odisha), and other grassroots innovators. The performances—ranging from **Sambalpuri folk dance to vibrant group acts**—brought a cultural flavor that kept the spirit of the mela warm and alive.
