

# **REPORT ON HEALTH SCREENING CAMP ON THE OCCASION OF WORLD POPULATION DAY**

On the occasion of World Population Day, a health screening camp was organized by the students of School of Nursing, Bhubaneswar campus at the Community Diagnostic Centre (CDC) of Centurion University, Bhubaneswar campus. The camp aimed to raise awareness about population-related health issues and to promote preventive health practices among the community.

B.Sc. Nursing students, under the guidance of faculty members, conducted various health assessments for the attendees. The parameters screened included:

Blood Pressure (BP)

Pulse Rate

Respiration Rate

Middle Upper Arm Circumference (MUAC)

Oxygen Saturation (SpO<sub>2</sub>)

Body Mass Index (BMI)

Random Blood Sugar (RBS) Count

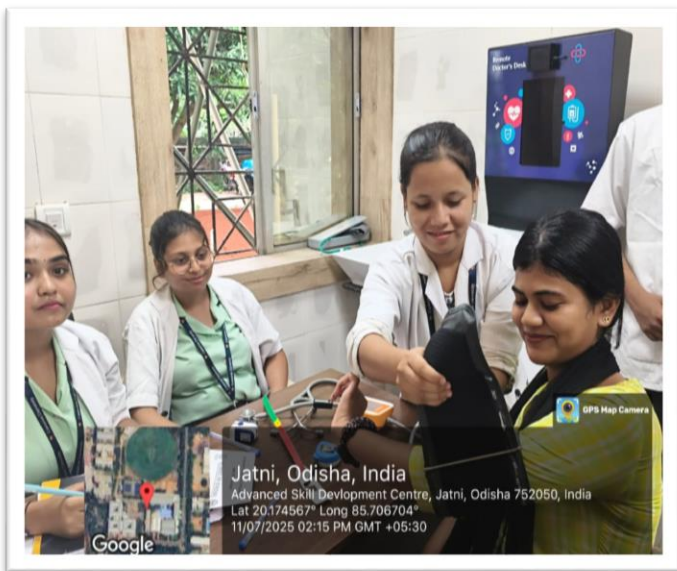
Complete Blood Count (CBC)

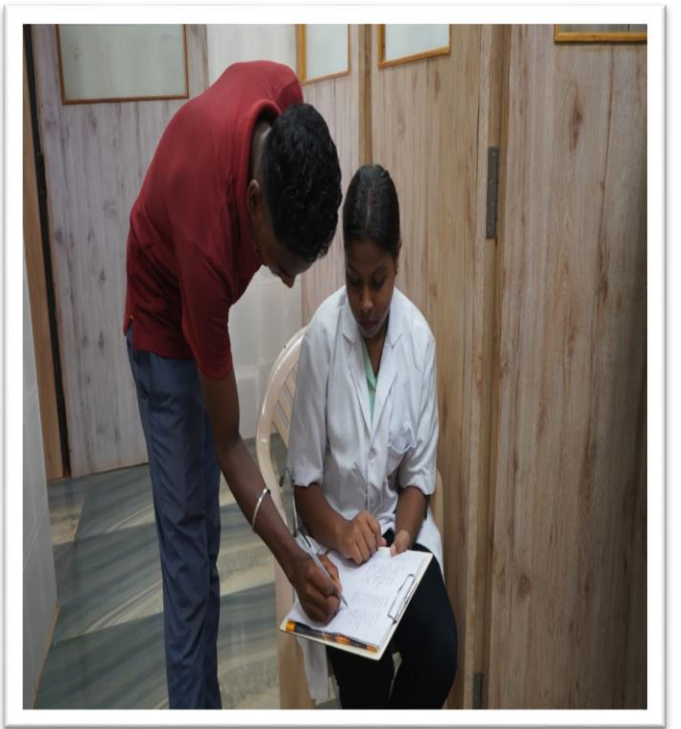
Other specific blood tests (Lipid profile, Liver function test, HbA1c, Renal function Test etc.)

The camp provided an opportunity for community members to receive free health check-ups and counselling on health maintenance. It also served as an important practical learning experience for the nursing students, enhancing their skills in clinical assessment and patient interaction. Individuals with abnormal findings were counseled about lifestyle modifications and the importance of follow-up care.

The collaborative efforts of the students and faculty contributed to the successful conduct of the camp and reinforced the importance of community health services in addressing public health challenges.
