## Introduction :

The Department of **Mining Engineering**, School of Engineering and Technology (**SoET**), Centurion University of Technology and Management (**CUTM**), Bhubaneswar Campus, organized a visit for its B.Tech students to attend a seminar titled “**My Role in Workplace Safety**” on **23<sup>rd</sup> February 2025 (Sunday)**.
