- **Student Awareness:** Raised awareness of student expectations and responsibilities.

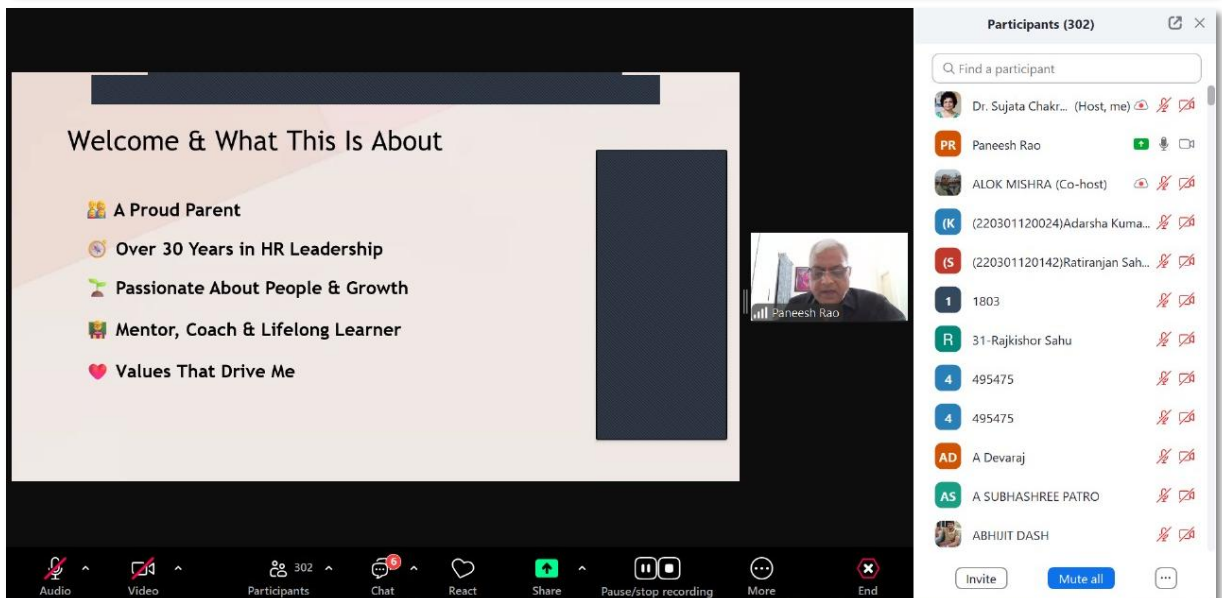
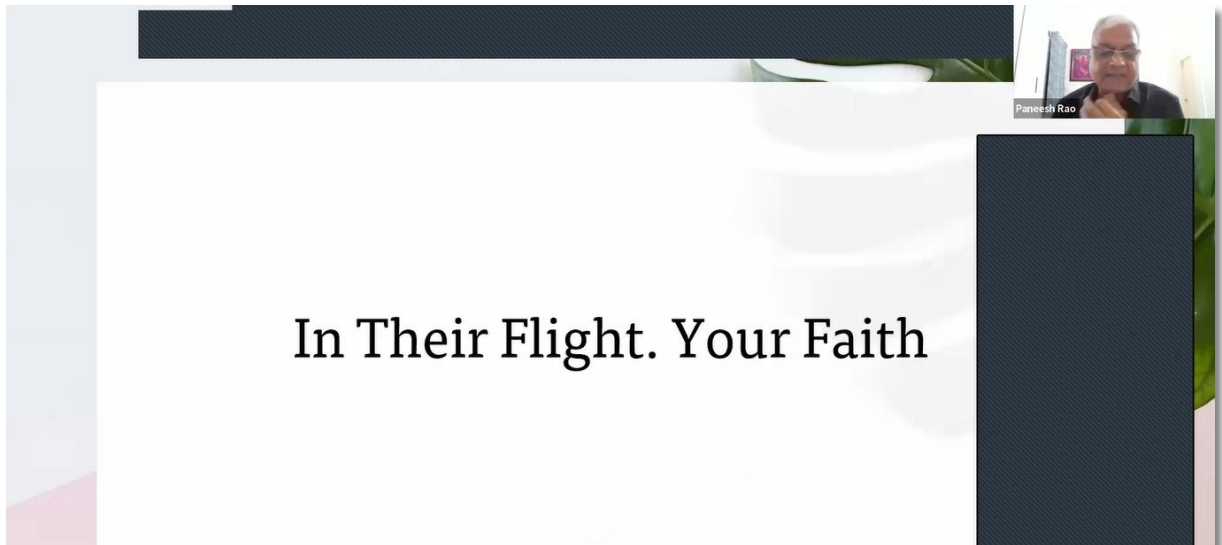
Feedback from Participants :

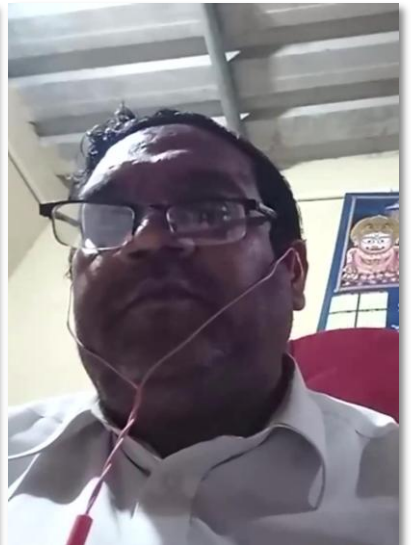
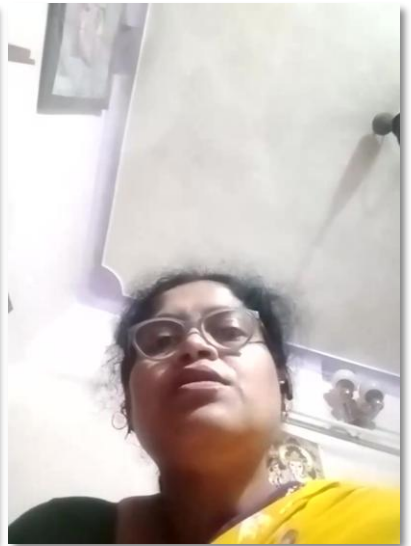
