The Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC) is an online library catalog system that provides library users with access to the library's collection. OPACs provide users with the ability to search, browse, and request materials from the library's collection. Koha OPAC helps users search books, journals, and other library materials online. Users can search the catalogue by title, author, subject, keyword, or ISBN. The OPAC provides quick and easy access to library resources anytime and anywhere.

Here are the main key use points for a Koha OPAC (Online Public Access Catalog) website:

- **First Click on Koha OPAC Website**
 - Open the library OPAC homepage.
 - Users can see the search bar, login option, and library information.
- **Search Any Book or Journal**
 - Enter the title, author name, subject, ISBN, or keyword in the search box.
 - Click the search button to find books, journals, e-books, theses, etc.
- **View Search Results**
 - Results display book title, author, call number, and availability status.
 - Users can filter results by:
 - Books
 - Journals
 - Authors
 - Subjects
 - Publication year
- **Check Availability**
 - Shows whether the item is:
 - Available
 - Issued
 - Reserved
- **Advanced Search**
 - Search using multiple fields:
 - Title
 - Author
 - Subject
 - ISBN
 - Material type
